#### RESPECTING



**Article 28**:All children and young people have a right to a primary education.

**Article 31**: All children and young people have a right to relax and play.

**Article 32**:Governments should protect children and young people from work that is dangerous or might harm their health or their education.

**Road Safety - The Car Park:** We have made a considerable effort to ensure that our car parks are safe for our children and families and will continue to do so.

Despite our efforts, there are still a number of parents/carers who are not following our advice. This creates delays in the car park, increases the likelihood of confrontation with other people (which we do not want) and puts our children at higher risk of injury.

Cranbrook Safer Neighbourhood Team have been supporting us in keeping our children safe in the car park.

**Warm Weather:** As the weather is now much warmer, please ensure that your child is appropriately dressed with a hat and sun cream applied before school. I would also encourage you to send in a bottle of water, labelled with his/her name, which can be topped up throughout the day, as all classes have access to drinking water.
